The 2025 WMA Annual Meeting will be held in Salt Lake City, Utah on April 16-17, 2025. We're planning for technical presentations on Wednesday and Thursday, April 16th and 17th. A tour and banquet will be held Thursday afternoon and evening followed by our annual awards ceremony. The tour is still to be determined. The Executive Board meeting will be held Tuesday night the 15th at 5PM, immediately following the North American Weather Modification Council Meeting. The WMA Business meeting will be held on Friday April 18th at 9AM.

Suggested topics for presentations include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Weather modification operations
- Weather modification research
- Surface and airborne instrumentations
(aerosols, cloud physics, precipitation, remote sensing, UAS, etc.)
- Validation/verification of weather modification programs
- Advancements in numerical modeling and hydrological systems
- Economic benefit analysis of cloud seeding
- Weather modification education and outreach
- Inadvertent weather modification due to anthropogenic sources

You can request to **both** present in the regular session and provide a poster of your presentation material. We are hoping for a minimum of 5 to 6 posters for the conference.
